Eliminates residency requirement for pregnant women

Another liberal Superior Court

Judge, Patrick Mahoney, has struck down a state law he doesn't like, resulting in well over \$1 million a year in extra taxes.

The law, which was passed in

1991, requires low-income women to live in California for 6 months to qualify for state-funded pregnancy and post-delivery care. Judge Mahoney did away with the residency requirement.

Just last year, Governor

Schwarzenegger vetoed another bill that would have eliminated the 6-month rule because of the great cost to taxpayers.

Many pregnant women moved to California for these benefits.
